Rationale of the Committee

The Appropriations Committee recommends funding ECO at \$0.76 for the 2016-2018 By-Line Funding Cycle. Although the Committee questions whether or not ECO will truly be able to impact all students, they believe that the small investment represents an opportunity with substantial reward and a small amount of risk. Finally, the Appropriations Committee recommends that ECO spend a significant amount of time ensuring that their current leadership create a sustainable succession plan that incorporate projections for growth.
