

Instructions - How to Vote

Please follow read and follow all instructions on this ballot to assure your votes are recorded correctly.

1. **The easiest way to vote is instantly and securely online. To cast your ballot online, go to this website: <https://assembly.cornell.edu/vote>** and use your Cornell net id and password to log in. You can vote at **any computer and any time** from April 13 until 4:30pm on April 24.
2. To be eligible to vote you must hold a regular full or part time, non-professorial appointment at the Ithaca or Geneva campuses of the university. Temporary employees, professors (including visiting professors), and those employed in programs outside the Ithaca area such as Cornell Cooperative Extension are not eligible to vote. Senior lecturers and academic staff are eligible to vote, except for professors.
3. You must fill out the *Referenda* section differently from the *Representative Elections* section. Follow the instructions provided respectively in each section. You may vote on all questions and elections presented in the ballot.
4. Send your ballot back by campus mail to the Office of the Assemblies, 109 Day Hall, in a sealed envelope. You must print clearly in the return address space:
 1. your full name, and
 2. your campus mail address
5. We strongly recommend that you also include on the envelope:
 1. your net id or your employee id, and
 2. your preferred daytime phone number.
6. Do not put your name or personal information on the ballot itself. We will discard your personal information before we examine the ballot to assure confidentiality.

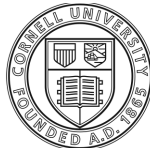
