## Changing the University Assembly Charter

1. A significant broadening of the UA's authority and a clearer mandate on both the UA and administrative units to consult with each other in developing new policy
2. Decreasing the overall size of the UA membership, and increasing the relative proportion of students and employees relative to faculty
3. Members of the Assembly and of its committees, including students, will serve two-year terms in nearly all cases
4. Leaders of constituent assemblies will become voting members of the UA ex-officio
5. Chairs of associated committees and managers of certain units closely tied to UA's authority would become non-voting members of the assembly, ex-officio

## Changing the University Assembly Charter

6. UA members would be able to serve and vote on UA committees and UA members would chair each committee
7. Committees and procedures of the Assembly would be specified in bylaws rather than the charter to improve adaptability
8. A new officer, the Vice Chair for Operations, would be charged to oversee and coordinate UA committees
9. The UA, through its Executive Board, would have the power to remove members from its committees
10. Authority has been removed in certain areas that are already governed by other parts of the assemblies system, notably academic matters (Faculty Senate) and CURW (SA and GPSA)
