

LGBTQ Ally Ambassador Plan for the IFC

18 Month Plan for Implementation

- I. March May, 2013
 - a. Determine form and legislate IFC specific plan that collaborates with the Student Assembly Initiative
 - b. Identify invested Greek leaders & build a team to present to various chapters
 - i. Attend Chapter meetings to solicit ideas and potential ambassadors
 - c. Email all IFC chapter delegates/presidents to find potential ambassadors
 - d. Host preliminary meeting and invite all candidates to the Know the Power of Your Words Campaign event (in April)
 - e. Work with Haven and SA to formulate appropriate overseeing board with representatives from IFC, Haven, and the SA
 - i. Create listserve
- II. June July, 2013
 - a. Plan Orientation Event for Fall 2013
 - i. Reserve location
 - ii. Book food vendor
 - iii. Finalize programming and presentations
 - iv. Choose date during Orientation Week
 - b. Contact all preliminary ambassadors with necessary information and Orientation event details
- III. August, 2013
 - a. Orientation Event for Ambassadors
 - i. Determine chapter participation
 - ii. Reward chapters who participate
 - b. Encourage participation in Haven sub organization events
- IV. September December, 2013
 - a. New ambassadors begin fulfilling responsibilities to respective brotherhoods
 - b. Steering Committee
 - i. Continue outreach to all chapters, especially those who have not yet determined an ambassador
 - ii. Plan Orientation Event for Spring 2014
 - iii. Finalize list of ambassadors (and account for turnover)
 - iv. Meet with newly elected IFC executive board to further discussion and the program



- Discuss the incorporation of the program into the standards for membership in the IFC
- V. January May, 2014
 - a. Orientation Event
 - i. Record Chapter participation
 - ii. Appropriately reward active chapters
 - b. Steering Committee
 - i. Follow up with chapters that are not participating
 - ii. Host meeting open to IFC, SA, and Haven to discuss the level of involvement in the sub organization activities
 - c. Determine the next Steering Committee (with input from Haven, IFC, and the SA)
