Student Assembly R. 7: Restructuring the Elections Committee

Sponsor: Enrico Bonatti on behalf of Other concerned students Propose on September 10th, 2013

Whereas, one of the most critical organs of the Student Assembly is the Elections Committee due to its role in organizing and mediating the election of candidates;

Whereas, there is no clear legislation with regards to the governance and composition of the Student Assembly Elections Committee;

Be it therefore resolved, that the Bylaws be amended to establish a 50% minimum composition of the Election Committee be composed of SA Seniors [if in a given year not enough Seniors are present, ex-officio members can be selected];

E. Elections Committee - The committee will coordinate and implement regularly scheduled and special elections of the SA and directly elected undergraduate representatives to the UA. The SA Director of Elections shall serve as chair with vote. The committee consists of ten voting members, of whom less than half may must also be the Senior members of the SA. If in a given year not enough Seniors are present, ex-officio members can be selected. At the first SA meeting of each academic year, The Staffing Committee will present a slate of proposed members to the SA for confirmation, which the SA must approve or disapprove in its entirety. The Staffing Committee may fill any subsequent vacancies with confirmation by the SA. No person may be a candidate in an election supervised by the committee in the same academic year when the person served as a voting member of the committee. Additionally, a member of the Cornell community that has been involved in a dispute with the Elections Committee and has subsequently been found guilty of a violation or disqualified from any race by such committee will not be able to be part of said committee.

Be it further resolved, that the charge of the Staffing Committee is amended to more explicitly state the committee application requirement for all committees:

F. Staffing Committee - The committee shall staff any vacant committee positions the Student Assembly (SA) is empowered to staff during meetings in early fall. The committee shall reevaluate the committee application outreach plan at the end of every spring term. The committee shall also evaluate SA committees' end of the year report, and determine if the SA committee and/or their composition need to be changed. The membership of this committee shall include the SA's President, Executive Vice President, Vice President of Finance, Vice President of Public Relations, and Vice President of Internal Operations, Vice President of Outreach, Vice President of Diversity and Inclusion, and all SA committee chairs. Ex-officio membership shall be granted to the Director of the Office of Assemblies. The VP Internal of Operations shall serve as chair. The VP of Internal Operations shall be responsible for reviewing all committee applications consulting with chairpersons of committees and recommending candidates for vacant committee positions to the Staffing Committee. Only those individuals who have applied to a committee through the online system will be eligible to

sit on any committee.
