Student Assembly R. 29: Student Supported Net-Print Improvements

Sponsor: Matthew Henderson Propose on November 18th, 2013

1 2	Whereas, Cornell University is committed to improving sustainability on campus;
3 4	Whereas, a total of 9,040,206 sides were printed using Cornell Information Technologies Net- Print service in the previous fiscal year;
5 6 7	Whereas, Net-Print was created to reduce unnecessary printing through usage pricing, while offering quality service at low rates to users;
8 9 10 11	Whereas, students, faculty, and staff lack an economic incentive to print using double-sided as opposed to single-sided printing under the current pricing structure;
12 13 14	Whereas, the default setting is not always double-sided when printing from lab computers and personal computers that use the Net-Print software;
15 16 17	Be it therefore resolved, that CIT pursue and achieve the capability for a price differential between single-sided and duplex printing as it relates to upcoming software changes;
18 19 20 21	Be it further resolved, that the CIT Labs and other departments that use Net-Print enact reduced rates for double-sided printing, as the option becomes available, in order to encourage duplex printing and reduce the costs to users (i.e. pricing at \$.09 for the front side and \$.07 for the back side of a page, as opposed to \$.09 per side);
22 23 24	Be it further resolved, that CIT work to ensure that double-sided printing is selected by default when using the Net-Print software from lab computers and personal computers;
25 26 27 28 29	Be it finally resolved, that this resolution is forwarded to CIT's Net-Print Division, and that all departments which have their own Net-Print printer(s) are encouraged to implement and maintain the recommendations identified in the attached department letter.
