3 4 5	Whereas, Engineering, Hotel, AA&P, CALs, and ILR have Net-Print stations in convenient locations located within school buildings;
6 7 8	Whereas, MVR has a printing station with only 1 printer hidden on the First Floor Dean's Room Lounge;
9 10 11	Whereas, this printer is not maintained or serviced regularly, out of paper, or out of ink;
12 13	Whereas, there is a strong consensus that Human Ecology students want a Quick Print Station located in a convenient area in the MVR building;
14 15 16 17	Be it therefore resolved, a quick service Net-Print station consisting of 2 new printers be installed and regularly maintained in one location: either upstairs by G73, downstairs near exit of G71, or around the corner by Martha's;
18 19 20	Be it further resolved, that this resolution is forwarded to the Dean of Human Ecology, the Assistant Dean of Human Ecology and the Cornell Information Technologies;
21 22 23	Be it finally resolved, the Dean's Undergraduate Advisory Council presents this resolution at their next meeting on December 6th
