1 Whereas, the Student Assembly Judicial Commission is responsible for insuring the integrity of
2 the SA's internal policies and procedures;

4 Whereas, the Student Assembly Judicial Commission is responsible for evaluating the actions
5 of the members of the SA including the President and Vice President;

7 Whereas, the attendance of the President and Vice President at closed meetings of the
8 Student Assembly Judicial Commission could be seen as a conflict of interest in a committee
9 who is charged with making objective decisions;

11 Be it therefore resolved, that Rule 3, Section 4 of the 2014 Spring Standing Rules be amended
12 to read as follows:

14 Rule 3
15 The President and Executive Vice President will be ex-officio members of every committee and
16 task force associated with the Student Assembly and whose activities are delineated in the SA
17 charter except the Student Assembly Judicial Commission. This includes but is not limited to
18 serving as ex-officio members of the SAFC and its executive board.
