6 7 8 9 10	Whereas, the attendance of the President and Vice President at closed meetings of the Student Assembly Judicial Commission could be seen as a conflict of interest in a committee who is charged with making objective decisions;
10 11 12 13	Be it therefore resolved, that Rule 3, Section 4 of the 2014 Spring Standing Rules be amended to read as follows:
13 14 15 16 17 18 19	Rule 3 The President and Executive Vice President will be ex-officio members of every committee and task force associated with the Student Assembly and whose activities are delineated in the SA charter except the Student Assembly Judicial Commission. This includes but is not limited to serving as ex-officio members of the SAFC and its executive board.
