6 7 8	Whereas, the Student Assembly Charter is currently ambiguous regarding the designation of ex-officio membership;
9 10 11 12 13 14	Whereas, there is currently not a clear distinction besides title between ex-officio members and general non-voting members (all members of the Cornell student body) that is granted to all Cornell undergraduate students. Ex-officio members and all other undergraduate students have full debating privileges; however, they are unable to vote or make motions;
15	Whereas, ex-officio members of the student assembly currently function as titled liaisons or
16	executive committee members with a specific area of expertise,
17	Be it therefore resolved , that Article IV section 1 part B of the Charter be amended as
18	follows:
19	Ex-officio Membership - All <u>undergraduate</u> members of the Cornell student body
20	are considered non-voting members of the SA, and are encouraged to attend and
21	participate in meetings. The SA may designate ex-officio <u>membership to any member of</u>
22	the Cornell community as deemed necessary for the operation of the Student Assembly.
