S.A. Resolution # 12 **Ex-Officio Standing Rules Changes**

4 5 6 **Whereas**, ex-officio members provide either perspective from other student 7 8 governance bodies or about a specific function of the Student Assembly, 9 Whereas, ex-officio members are a necessary asset to the Student Assembly, 10 Whereas, the responsibilities of ex-officio members are often confused, 11 12 13 Be it therefore resolved, that the standing rules be amended as follows, 14 15 Rule 1 (Ethical Standards and Attendance Policy)- Attendance is required at all regularly scheduled meetings for all voting and ex-officio members who serve in a liaison 16 17 capacity. Absences will not be recorded for ex-officio liaison members if the absence is a result of a conflicting obligation related to their respective organization. Attendance 18 requirements for all other ex-officio members shall be at the discretion of the executive 19 20 committee. Regularly scheduled meetings are held Thursdays, from 4:45 until 6:30 p.m., while undergraduate colleges are in session. Informal meetings are considered 21 22 official meetings when held in lieu of regular Thursday meetings. 23 24 Rule 2 (Ethical Standards and Attendance Policy)- Attendance at all informal, 25 organizational and specially-scheduled meetings is required, when the Executive Committee provides SA members at least 72 hours prior notice of the meeting. Such 26 meetings shall be considered "regularly scheduled meetings," for the purpose of 27 accruing absences. Ex-officio members will be excused from these meetings unless 28 29 notified otherwise by the Executive Committee. 30 31 Rule 8 (Outreach Guidelines and Member Responsibilities) – All ex-officio members acting in liaison positions should report relevant information to the Student Assembly 32 33 and about their respective organization and report relevant actions of the assembly to 34 their respective organization as they see fit to fulfill their outreach obligation. 35 36 37 **Respectfully Submitted**,
