Whereas, the current attendance policy for Student Assembly members is absolute in that a member with three consecutive absences or six cumulative absences during their term will lose their seat;

10 **Whereas**, this attendance policy has not been correctly enforced in the past; 11

- Whereas, this attendance policy makes no distinctions between an excused and unexcused
 absence;
 absence;
- Whereas, there are potential circumstances where a seat could be vacated and remain
 vacant for the rest of the year, or the enforcement of this policy could put the Student
 Assembly in a perpetual state of elections;

Be it therefore resolved, that Article IV Section 5 of the Student Assembly Charter is amended as follows (italicized and red font denotes additions);

22 Section 5: Absentees

- Any voting members who are absent for three consecutive regularly scheduled meetings or for six regularly scheduled meetings cumulatively during their term, will lose their right to
- 25 vote and their position will be considered vacated. <u>The Executive Committee may avert</u>
- 26 <u>such a vacancy by a two-thirds agreement of voting Executive Committee members. The</u>
- 27 Executive Committee should consider the reasoning for past absences and the likelihood of
- 28 *future absences in making their decision. The same action must be taken to avert a*
- 29 vacancy whenever the three consecutive absences or the six cumulative absences mark is
 30 exceeded.
