Wł	nereas, the Quarter System was formally enacted in 2011 with the intent to decrease high-risk drinking among first-year students,		
Wl	hereas , there remains uncertainty about the unintended consequences of the Quarter System, including social activity and alcohol consumption in unregulated, off- campus environments,		
Wł	hereas, a mission of the Student Assembly is to promote the safety of the student body and student communities and to enhance the overall student experience,		
Wł	nereas, Article III Section 2 of the Student Assembly Charter states that one of the six principal actions of the Assembly is investigation: "action of the SA to gain information on issues pertinent to its purview,"		
Be	it therefore resolved , that the Student Assembly calls for the creation of an ad-hoc investigation committee for the purpose of exploring the impact and use of the Quarter System,		
Be	it further resolved , that the body produces a comprehensive report of its findings t be reviewed by the Student Assembly by April 15, 2015 and cease operations thereafter,		
Be	it finally resolved , that the committee will include at least one SA representative, maintain even representation among Greek and non-Greek students, and be co- chaired by a member of the Student Assembly and a member of the Greek Tri- Council
