Resolution #28 1 **Increasing Awareness of Available Accommodations During** 2 **Event Registration** 3 4 5 6 7 8 9 Sponsored by: Kelly McClure '16, Max Weisbrod '16, Shivang Tayal '16 Whereas accessibility information is not made available during the registration of spaces for events. 10 Whereas Americans with Disability Act (ADA) compliance does not manifest itself in 11 equally accessible spaces from building to building and college to college even when those 12 spaces are in compliance, 13 14 Whereas Student Disability Services (SDS) has systematically collected some information 15 on the accessibility of spaces, 16 17 Whereas a metric measuring the accessibility of spaces would be valuable for future 18 diversity initiatives initiated by the Student Assembly, other Shared Governance bodies, and 19 Cornell Administration, 20 21 Be it therefore resolved that SACIDI create, adopt, or modify a suitable metric to 22 reliably communicate the accessibility features of reservable spaces on campus, 23 24 It is further resolved that SACIDI take a full report of the reservable spaces on campus 25 and measure them against the aforementioned metric. 26 27 It is further resolved that SACIDI petition the relevant bodies to have this new metric 28 displayed on all room and event registration sites available to the Cornell community, 29 30 It is finally resolved that SACIDI will collaborate in the fulfillment of all mandates of this 31 resolution with all willing parties, including but not limited to SDS, the Cornell Union for 32 Disability Awareness (CUDA), and Facilities, to ensure as rapid a rollout as is reasonable. 33 34 Kelly McClure '16 35 36 Max Weisbrod '16 37 38 **Shivang Tayal '16** 39 Vice President for Diversity & Inclusion, Student Assembly 40
