Statement and Certification

According to the Bylaws of Cornell University, Article II, Section 2.a(4)(e) to be eligible a candidate must:

One trustee shall be elected from among and by the nonacademic staff and employees of the University at Ithaca and Geneva for a term of four years.

Article II, Section 5 further states, in part, that for the purposes of elections:

The employees of the university shall consist of those persons employed at Ithaca and Geneva (including both nonacademic and nonprofessorial academic employees) who are not members of the University Faculty as defined in Article XII of these Bylaws and who are not students as defined in (ii) above.

Review all election rules and materials provided by the Trustee Nominating Committee and agree by the terms therein both in letter and in spirit.

By my signature below, I state I am eligible and willing to serve in the position on the Board of Trustees under the terms specified above. All materials I have supplied are accurate and complete to the best of my knowledge. I understand a purposeful misrepresentation to the Trustee Nominating Committee or any university officials involved in administration of elections may result in disciplinary action, including loss of eligibility and referral to the Judicial Administrator.
