

University Assembly R. 16: Appoint University Hearing and Review Members for Spring 2013

Description:

Arrange for the appointment of members to the University Hearing and Review Boards

Provides pool for filling remaining vacancies, with preference to appointees who can serve longest. Authorizes explicitly the practice of recruiting from CIVR student staff when regular pool does not have enough students with summer availability.

Content:

WHEREAS the Codes and Judicial Committee received applications for service on the University Hearing and Review Boards (UHRB) from students and employees and made recommendations on appointments consistent with this resolution.

WHEREAS the Executive Board of the Assembly has in the past authorized the appointment of summer panel members from student staff in Campus Information and Visitor Relations (CIVR) to UHRB when insufficient numbers of regular appointees were available.

RESOLVED the following student members are appointed to the UHRB for terms lasting from 1 June, 2013 until 31 May, 2015:

RESOLVED the following employee members are appointed to the UHRB for terms lasting from 1 June, 2013 until 31 May, 2015:

RESOLVED as additional student vacancies arise between 1 June, 2013 and 31 May, 2014 additional members shall be chosen at random from the following pool of conditionally qualified applicants (hereafter "qualified applicants") with preference to those who can serve through the end of the term:

RESOLVED should the Office of the Judicial Administrator (OJA) be unable to secure a sufficient number of student members for a summer hearing panel, it may select additional panelists from the "qualified applicants" list even if they have not been appointed to a regular term on UHRB.

RESOLVED should the OJA still be unable to select a sufficient number of student members for a summer hearing, it may with approval of the Director of Campus Relations solicit volunteers from the summer student staff of CIVR.
