UA Resolution # 10 Investigating an Open Access Policy for Cornell

2 3	Whereas, it is in the mission of Cornell to "preserve and disseminate knowledge," [i]
4	and the widest dissemination of knowledge benefits not only individual scholars and
5 6	their discipline, but more importantly, the people of New York and the world,
7	Whereas, the Faculty Senate has passed resolutions urging "faculty to deposit preprint
8	or postprint copies of articles in an open access repository" [ii] and supporting "alternatives to commercial venues for scholarly communication" [iii],
10	afternatives to commercial venues for scholarry communication [m],
11	Whereas, the University Library is actively engaged in advancing open access to
12	scholarly work including the Library's open-source publishing platform [iv] and a pilot
13	fund [v] designated by the Library and the Office of the Provost to pay the fees to
14	publish in open-access journals in the absence of other funding sources,
15	
16	Whereas, the Library has established eCommons [vi] as a repository for the
17	University's digital works and owns and operates arXiv.org [vii], home to over 900,000
18	electronic pre-prints in physics, mathematics, computer science, quantitative biology,
19	quantitative finance and statistics,
20 21	Whereas, many universities [viii], states [ix], and non-profit [x] and federal funding
22	agencies [xi] have adopted open access publishing policies,
23	agencies [xi] have adopted open access publishing policies,
24	Whereas, the University Library Board as well as administrators of eCommons are in
25	support of broadening the scope of Cornell's open access repositories
26	
27	Be it therefore resolved, a committee will be established to investigate the feasibility
28	of and campus support for implementing an open access policy (included in the
29	resolution's appendix) wherein each faculty member grants to Cornell permission to
30	make available her or his scholarly articles and to exercise the copyright in those
31	articles,
32	
33	Resolved , that this committee will at a minimum consist of one representative from
34 35	each of the following: the University Assembly, the Graduate and Professional Student Assembly, the University Faculty Library Board, the University Library, the Office of the
36	Vice Provost for Research, and the Faculty Senate. Any other member of the Cornell
37	campus community (student, staff, faculty) may also be part of this committee,
38	campus community (student, stan, ractity) may also be part of this committee,
39	Resolved, that this committee will consider items such as but not limited to: how an
40	open access policy would benefit the Cornell community including its students, alumni,
41	faculty/staff, and different departments, colleges, and disciplines; how an open access
42	publishing policy can be interfaced with data sharing plans (mandated for National
