25	By delegation from the Assembly, the Committee will review any proposed motion related to
26	• Campus Code of Conduct;
27	• recruitment and appointment of members to the University Hearing and Review

29	• creation, maintenance and availability of a Community Bill of Rights.

31	The Committee may propose, review, and amend resolutions, as it deems appropriate. The
32	Committee must approve resolutions referred for its consideration before they can be
33	advanced to the Assembly for a vote and for debate.
