U.A. Resolution # 2

Charter Change Aligning the University Assembly's Role in a Judicial Administrator Search Process with Practice September 22, 2015

1 2	<u>Sponsored by</u> : G. Kaufman, Undergraduate; Member, University Assembly

4	Whereas, Article 3.2.1 of the University Assembly Charter states "The Assembly must approve
5	each appointment or reappointment by the President of the University to the following
6	offices: the Judicial Administrator, the University Ombudsman, and the Judicial Codes
7	Counselor. In the event of a vacancy in any of these positions, the President or a
8	designee will appoint a search committee to which the Assembly may appoint a
9	representative " (Emphasis added); and
10	
11	Whereas, the Article II, Section A, Subsection 3 of Campus Code of Conduct reads "upon the
12	University Assembly chair's receipt of notice of the Judicial Administrator's resignation
13	or removal, the chair shall convene a six-member search committee, including two
14	members appointed by the President and four members appointed by the University
15	Assembly, to propose two or more nominees to the President."; and
16	Will serve the Commerce Code of Combert server doe the University Assembles Charter in defining
17 18	Whereas, the Campus Code of Conduct supersedes the University Assembly Charter in defining the search process for Judicial Administrator; and
18 19	the search process for Judicial Administrator, and
20	Whereas, in the current search Judicial Administrator search the President's Office and
20	Assembly are adhering to the procedure laid out in the Code of Conduct; and
22	Assembly are adhering to the procedure faid out in the code of conduct, and
23	Whereas, an incongruity between the Assembly's Charter and the Campus Code of Conduct
24	creates confusion and can lead to misinterpretation of the Assembly's role in a search; be
25	it therefore
26	
27	Resolved that Article 3.2.1 of the University Assembly Charter be amended to read:
28	
29	• The Assembly must approve each appointment or reappointment by the President of the
30	University to the following offices: the Judicial Administrator, the University
31	Ombudsman, and the Judicial Codes Counselor. In the event of a vacancy in the offices
32	of the University Ombudsman or Judicial Codes Counselor of these positions, the
33	President or a designee will appoint a search committee to which the Assembly may

34	appoint a representative. In the event of a vacancy in the Judicial Administrator's office,
35	the procedure laid out in Article II, Section A, Subsection 3 of Campus Code of Conduct
36	for constituting a search will be followed. Incumbent occupants of each office may serve
37	any number of consecutive terms; however, no single term may exceed two years in
38	duration.
